School Specific Actions

Battle Born Academy is using allocated Title III funding to:

- Provide an after-school tutoring program for EL students including staffing and materials. The program is opt-in and targets primarily students in grades 2-5. The program aims to supplement in-school instruction with additional, hands-on language development in small, intensive groups.
- Provide a daily homeroom/small-group for newcomer EL students (less than 2 years in country) to provide additional language and emotional supports in Spanish
- Increase family engagement of EL students, especially those in the after-school tutoring program and the newcomer homeroom
